FINAL ORDER

This matter came before the Commission on Ethics, meeting in public session on April 21, 2017, on the timely appeal of Christopher Shoemaker, pursuant to Section 112.3145(7)(f), Florida Statutes, which assesses an automatic fine of \$25 per day on a person who fails to timely file a required CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests. The Commission may waive the fine in whole or in part for good cause shown, based on "unusual circumstances" surrounding the failure to file by the designated date. There are no matters in dispute. Appellant did not request a hearing before the Commission.

Findings of Fact

1. According to information provided to the Commission, Appellant was a member of the Highlands County Planning and Zoning Commission/Zoning Board Of Adjustment, a position requiring the filing of a CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, for the year 2015. In 2016, the designated due date for submitting a 2015 CE Form 1 annual filing was July 1, 2016, with a grace period ending on September 1, 2016.

2. No later than June 1, 2016, the Highlands County Supervisor of Elections sent Appellant a 2015 CE Form 1. This mailing was sent to 804 Golfside Lane, Sebring, FL 33870.

3. No later than July 31, 2016, the Highlands County Supervisor of Elections sent Appellant a Notice of Delinquency by certified mail. This notice was also sent to the 804

Golfside Lane. The notice was returned by the Post Office marked "Return to Sender – Unclaimed, Unable to Forward."

4. On August 17, 2016, the Commission mailed Appellant a postcard intended to remind him of his obligation to file a 2015 CE Form 1. The Commission mailed the postcard to the 804 Golfside Lane address.

5. On August 26, 2016, the Highlands County Supervisor of Elections obtained a new address for Appellant and resent Appellant the Notice of Delinquency by certified mail. This notice was sent to 10461 Washington Palm Way, Apt. 3445, Ft. Myers, FL 33966. The notice was delivered and signed by someone on September 3, 2016.

6. On September 7, 2016, six days after the grace period expired, the Commission mailed Appellant a courtesy notice informing him that an automatic fine had begun to accrue. The Commission mailed this notice to the 804 Golfside Lane address.

7. On September 9, 2016, Appellant submitted his 2015 CE Form 1 to the Highlands County Supervisor of Elections.

8. On September 27, 2016, Appellant called the Commission and informed Commission staff that he had changed jobs and moved from Sebring to Fort Myers. He also stated that the notices sent by the Highlands County Supervisor of Elections and the Commission were sent to his previous residence and were not forwarded to him. Commission staff advised Appellant of his obligation to file CE Form 1F with the Highlands County Supervisor of Elections and of his right to appeal. Appellant provided the Commission with his current mailing address of 10461 Washington Palm Way, Apt. 3445, Ft. Myers, FL 33966-7917.

9. The amount of fine automatically assessed against Appellant was \$200.

10. On January 6, 2017, Appellant submitted his appeal to the Commission. In his appeal, Appellant claims that he failed to timely file his disclosure form due to lack of notice. Appellant states that he relocated from Sebring to Fort Myers on June 20, 2016 to begin a new job, and that all the notices from the from the Highlands County Supervisor of Elections and the Commission regarding his financial disclosure obligation were mailed to his previous address in Sebring and were not forwarded to him in Fort Myers. Appellant further states that it was not until he called the Financial Disclosure Coordinator that he first became aware of his filing obligation. Upon becoming aware of his filing obligation, Appellant immediately completed and filed the 2015 CE Form 1.

11. On February 8, 2017, the Commission mailed a Notice of Assessment of Automatic Fine to the 10461 Washington Palm Way address provided by Appellant. This mailing indicated the total of Appellant's accrued automatic fine. The mailing also included a notice of his right to appeal the fine.

Conclusions of Law

12. The Commission has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this proceeding pursuant to Section 112.3145, Florida Statutes.

13. Financial disclosure is required of public officials and employees because it enables the public to evaluate potential conflicts of interest, deters corruption, and increases public confidence in government. In order to increase compliance, beginning in 2001 the Legislature provided for an automatic fine of \$25 per day, up to a cap of \$1,500, on persons who do not timely file their financial disclosure statements. Under the law, the Legislature permitted the Commission to waive a fine only "based upon unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date"

14. Commission Rule 34-8.215, F.A.C., defines "unusual circumstances" as follows:

uncommon, rare or sudden events over which the reporting individual has no control and which directly result in the failure to act in accordance with the filing requirement. Circumstances which allow for time in which to take those steps necessary to assure compliance with the filing requirement shall be deemed not to constitute unusual circumstances.

15. Appellant's basis for the appeal of his fine is that he did not receive notice of his obligation to file the 2015 CE Form 1, or any of the notices sent to him by the Highlands County Supervisor of Elections or the Commission since he had moved from Sebring to Fort Myers to begin a new job in June 2016, and all of the notices were sent to Sebring. It appears that notices concerning Appellant's filing obligations were sent to his previous residence in Sebring and were not forwarded to him in Fort Myers. Appellant's claim is supported by documentation provided by him to the Commission substantiating his claim that he relocated to Fort Myers on June 20, 2016. Appellant's basis for the appeal of his fine, that he did not receive notification of his obligation to file the 2015 CE Form 1, constitutes an "unusual circumstance" that justifies waiving the \$200 fine.

Order

Based on the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission hereby waives the assessed fine of \$200.

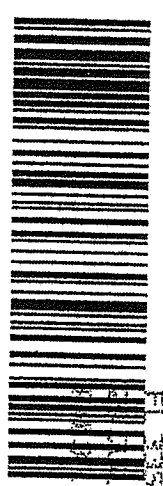
