FINAL ORDER

This matter came before the Commission on Ethics, meeting in public session on April 21, 2017, on the timely appeal of Mary Moore, pursuant to Section 112.3145(7)(f), Florida Statutes, which assesses an automatic fine of \$25 per day on a person who fails to timely file a required CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests. The Commission may waive the fine in whole or in part for good cause shown, based on "unusual circumstances" surrounding the failure to file by the designated date. There are no matters in dispute. Appellant did not request a hearing before the Commission.

Findings of Fact

1. According to information provided to the Commission, Appellant served as a member of the Fort Myers Housing Authority, a position requiring the filing of a CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, for the year 2015. In 2016, the designated due date for submitting a 2015 CE Form 1 annual filing was July 1, 2016, with a grace period ending on September 1, 2016.

2. No later than June 1, 2016, the Lee County Supervisor of Elections sent Appellant a 2015 CE Form 1. This mailing was sent to 2614 Larmie Street, Fort Myers, FL 33916.

3. No later than July 31, 2016, the Lee County Supervisor of Elections sent Appellant a Notice of Delinquency by certified mail. This notice was also sent to the 2614

Larmie Street address. The notice was returned by the Post Office marked "Return to Sender, Unclaimed, Unable to Forward."

4. On August 17, 2016, the Commission mailed Appellant a postcard intended to remind her of her obligation to file a 2015 CE Form 1. The Commission mailed the postcard to the 2614 Larmie Street address.

5. On September 7, 2016, six days after the grace period expired, the Commission mailed Appellant a courtesy notice informing her that an automatic fine had begun to accrue. The Commission mailed this notice to the 2614 Larmie Street address.

6. On September 29, 2016, Appellant submitted her 2015 CE Form 1 to the Lee County Supervisor of Elections. The disclosure form listed her address as the 2614 Larmie Street address.

7. The amount of fine automatically assessed against Appellant was \$700.

8. On February 8, 2017, the Commission mailed a Notice of Assessment of Automatic Fine to the 2614 Larmie Street address. This mailing indicated the total of Appellant's accrued automatic fine. The mailing also included a notice of her right to appeal the fine.

9. On February 27, 2017, Appellant submitted her appeal to the Commission. In her appeal, Appellant claims that she timely filed her disclosure form. Appellant states that she mailed the 2015 CE Form 1 twice to the Lee County Supervisor of Elections, and then hand-delivered it once to the Lee County Supervisor of Elections. She states that she did not keep a copy of the forms that she mailed or hand-delivered. Appellant's appeal lists her address as 2614 Larmie Street, Fort Myers, FL 33916.

Conclusions of Law

10. The Commission has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this proceeding pursuant to Section 112.3145, Florida Statutes.

11. Financial disclosure is required of public officials and employees because it enables the public to evaluate potential conflicts of interest, deters corruption, and increases public confidence in government. In order to increase compliance, beginning in 2001 the Legislature provided for an automatic fine of \$25 per day, up to a cap of \$1,500, on persons who do not timely file their financial disclosure statements. Under the law, the Legislature permitted the Commission to waive a fine only "based upon unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date"

12. Commission Rule 34-8.215, F.A.C., defines "unusual circumstances" as follows:

uncommon, rare or sudden events over which the reporting individual has no control and which directly result in the failure to act in accordance with the filing requirement. Circumstances which allow for time in which to take those steps necessary to assure compliance with the filing requirement shall be deemed not to constitute unusual circumstances.

13. Appellant's basis for the appeal of her fine is that she timely filed her 2015 CE 2015 Form 1 by mailing it twice to the Lee County Supervisor of Elections, and then hand-delivering it. Appellant, however, has not provided any documentation to show that she mailed her financial disclosure forms to the Supervisor of Elections in a timely manner, nor did she retain a copy of the 2015 CE Form 1 completed prior to the filing deadline. Notices were sent to Appellant's address notifying her of her financial disclosure obligation and she failed to question why the notices were being sent. Appellant has not supported her claim of timely filing, nor has she pointed to any "uncommon, rare or sudden events" that prevented her from filing the 2015

CE Form 1 in a timely manner. Therefore, Appellant has not identified any "unusual circumstance" that would justify waiver of the \$700 fine.

Order

Based on the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission hereby affirms the assessed fine of \$700 and denies the appeal. The fine shall be paid to the Commission on Ethics, P.O. Drawer 15709, Tallahassee, FL 32317-5709, within 30 days of the date this order is rendered, unless other payment arrangements are made by contacting Kimberly Holmes, Financial Disclosure Coordinator, at the address below or by telephone at (850) 488-7864.



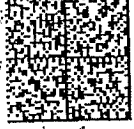
