FINAL ORDER

This matter came before the Commission on Ethics, meeting in public session on April 21, 2017, on the timely appeal of Roger Zona, pursuant to Section 112.3145(7)(f), Florida Statutes, which assesses an automatic fine of \$25 per day on a person who fails to timely file a required CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests. The Commission may waive the fine in whole or in part for good cause shown, based on "unusual circumstances" surrounding the failure to file by the designated date. There are no matters in dispute. Appellant did not request a hearing before the Commission.

Findings of Fact

1. According to information provided to the Commission, Appellant was a member of the Boynton Beach Building Board of Adjustment and Appeals, a position requiring the filing of a CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, for the year 2015. In 2016, the designated due date for submitting a 2015 CE Form 1 annual filing was July 1, 2016, with a grace period ending on September 1, 2016.

2. No later than June 1, 2016, the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections sent Appellant a 2015 CE Form 1. This mailing was sent to 910 SW 27th Place, Boynton Beach, FL 33435.

3. No later than July 31, 2016, the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections sent Appellant a Notice of Delinquency by certified mail. This notice was also sent to the 910 SW 27th Place address. The notice was delivered and signed for by Appellant.

4. On August 17, 2016, the Commission mailed Appellant a postcard intended to remind him of his obligation to file a 2015 CE Form 1. The Commission mailed the postcard to the 910 SW 27th Place address.

5. On August 26, 2016, A Commission staff member left a message on Appellant's voice mail regarding his financial disclosure obligation.

6. On September 7, 2016, six days after the grace period expired, the Commission mailed Appellant a courtesy notice informing him that an automatic fine had begun to accrue. The Commission mailed this notice to the 910 SW 27th Place address.

7. On September 13, 2016, Appellant submitted his 2015 CE Form 1 to the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections.

8. The amount of fine automatically assessed against Appellant was \$300.

9. On February 21, 2017, the Commission mailed a Notice of Assessment of Automatic Fine to the 910 SW 27th Place address. This mailing indicated the total of Appellant's accrued automatic fine. The mailing also included a notice of his right to appeal the fine.

10. On March 9, 2017, Appellant submitted his appeal to the Commission. In his appeal, Appellant claims he failed to timely file his disclosure form due "other unusual circumstances." Appellant states that he failed to timely file his 2015 CE Form 1 because his term on the Boynton Beach Building Board of Adjustment and Appeals expired December 2016, and the last meeting of the Board was November 6, 2014. He further states that he filed his 2014 CE Form 1 within 30 days of his appointment to the Board on May 6, 2014. Commission

records, however, reflect that Appellant filed his 2014 CE Form 1 with the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections on August 25, 2015. Appellant relates that he did not receive any further notifications from the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections regarding his financial disclosure obligation, and, therefore, that he is not in violation of his filing requirement. Commission records, however, reflect that all the notices from the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections and the Commission were sent to the same address Appellant listed on his 2015 CE Form 1 and in his appeal, and further, that Appellant signed for the receipt for the certified notice sent by the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections.

Conclusions of Law

11. The Commission has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this proceeding pursuant to Section 112.3145, Florida Statutes.

12. Financial disclosure is required of public officials and employees because it enables the public to evaluate potential conflicts of interest, deters corruption, and increases public confidence in government. In order to increase compliance, beginning in 2001 the Legislature provided for an automatic fine of \$25 per day, up to a cap of \$1,500, on persons who do not timely file their financial disclosure statements. Under the law, the Legislature permitted the Commission to waive a fine only "based upon unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date"

13. Commission Rule 34-8.215, F.A.C., defines "unusual circumstances" as follows:

uncommon, rare or sudden events over which the reporting individual has no control and which directly result in the failure to act in accordance with the filing requirement. Circumstances which allow for time in which to take those steps necessary to assure compliance with the filing requirement shall be deemed not to constitute unusual circumstances.

14. Appellant mistakenly believed that he did not have a financial disclosure obligation since the Boynton Beach Building Board of Adjustment and Appeals had not met since November 2014 and, therefore, that he was not required to file financial disclosure. Appellant's mistaken belief, however, does not justify his failure to timely file his 2015 CE Form 1. Even though Appellant claims that he did not receive any further notifications from the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections, all of the notices sent by the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections and the Commission regarding his financial disclosure obligation were sent to Appellant's address. In fact, Appellant signed for the receipt of the notice from the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections regarding his financial disclosure obligation. Appellant has not pointed to any uncommon, rare, or sudden event that prevented him from timely filing, therefore, he has not established any "unusual circumstance" that justifies waiver of the \$300 fine.

Order

Based on the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission hereby affirms the assessed fine of \$300 and denies the appeal. The fine shall be paid to the Commission on Ethics, P.O. Drawer 15709, Tallahassee, FL 32317-5709, within 30 days of the date this order is rendered, unless other payment arrangements are made by contacting Kimberly Holmes, Financial Disclosure Coordinator, at the address below or by telephone at (850) 488-7864.



Please consider this letter as an appeal to waive the penalty clause and the assessed fine based on the following facts.


