**ORDER DECLARING FINANCIAL
DISCLOSURE FINE UNCOLLECTIBLE**

This matter came before the Commission on Ethics meeting in public session on Friday, June 3, 2016, in the matter of P Morgan Hill. Section 112.3145(7)(f), Florida Statutes, assesses an automatic fine of \$25 per day on each person who is required to file an annual Statement of Financial Interests (CE Form 1), but whose form is not timely filed, up to a maximum of \$1,500.

1. P Morgan Hill served as a member of the Marathon Planning Commission and, as such, was required to file a 2012 CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, not later than September 2, 2013.

2. P Morgan Hill's CE Form 1 was received six days late, resulting in an automatic fine of \$150.00.

3. Under Section 112.3145(7)(i), Florida Statutes, any fine that is not waived by a Final Order of the Commission, and remains unpaid more than 60 days after the Notice of Payment Due is transmitted, must be submitted to the Department of Financial Services as a claim, debt or other obligation owed to the state. P Morgan Hill's fine was referred to collections, as provided in Section 17.20, Florida Statutes, on May 27, 2014.

4. Under Section 17.20(3)(b), Florida Statutes, an agency may request an exemption when assignment to a collections agency would be inappropriate. The agency must provide a written request, explaining the reasons the agency believes the account should be precluded from collections.

5. In April of 2016, internet research by staff of the Commission on Ethics and verification from the staff of the Marathon Planning Commission confirmed that P Morgan Hill (Patricia Ann Morgan Hill) passed away on March 19, 2014.

6. On its own motion, the Commission determines that the \$150 fine assessed against P Morgan Hill is uncollectible and requests that the Department of Financial Services consider it to be exempt from collection.

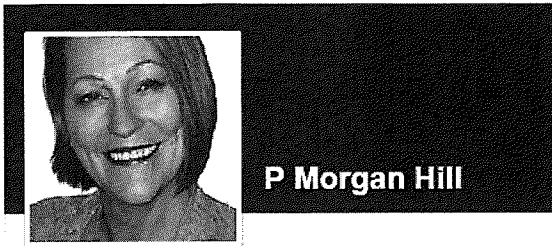
