Language to be considered includes the language presented to the Commission at its hearing on this subject on June 7, 2019, language submitted to the Commission prior to the July 26, 2019, workshop, language submitted to the Commission during the July 26, 2019, workshop, and language discussed by the Commission during the hearing.
