TALLAHASSEE—February 10, 2021— The State of Florida Commission on Ethics, in its public session meeting on February 5th, unanimously elected JOANNE LEZNOFF, as Chair for the 2021-2022 term. Ms. Leznoff was appointed by Speaker of the House Richard Corcoran in 2018 and subsequently reappointed by Speaker Oliva in 2020. A resident of Northeast Florida, Ms. Leznoff retired after a 31-year career in state government, most recently serving as the Staff Director of the Appropriations Committee of the Florida House of Representatives. JOHN GRANT was unanimously elected Vice Chair. He currently practices law in the Tampa Bay area and teaches law and criminal justice at the college level. Mr. Grant previously served as a Legislator in both the Florida House of Representatives and the Florida Senate. This is his third time serving on the Commission. His most recent appointment was by Governor DeSantis in 2019.
