Financial Disclosures for Elected Local Officers; Requires specified local officers to file full & public disclosure of financial interests.

HB 501: Prohibition of Public Funds for Lobbying
General Bill by Gregory

Prohibition of Public Funds for Lobbying; Prohibits local governments and not-for-profit organizations from using public funds to retain lobbyists; provides exceptions for local government full-time employees; provides sanctions for violations; authorizes people to file complaints with the Commission on Ethics; requires commission to provide a report to specified entities; specifies procedures for disciplining violators.
