FINAL ORDER RESCINDING FINE

This matter came before the Commission on Ethics (Commission), on its own motion, meeting in public session on June 3, 2022, on appeal of the Appellant, pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes, which assesses an automatic fine of \$25 per day on a person who fails to timely file a required CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests. The Commission may, on its own motion, waive the fine in whole or in part for good cause shown, based on "unusual circumstances" surrounding the failure to file by the designated date. There are no matters in dispute. Appellant did request a hearing before the Commission.

Findings of Fact

1. According to information provided to the Commission, the Appellant serves or had served as a member of the Board of Medicine for the Florida Department of Health, a position requiring the filing of a CE Form 1, "Statement of Financial Interests," for the year 2018. In 2019, the designated due date for submitting a 2018 CE Form 1 annual filing was July 1, 2019, with a grace period ending on September 3, 2019.

- 2. On May 15, 2019, the Commission sent to the Appellant a blank 2018 CE Form 1. The blank 2018 CE Form 1 was mailed to the Appellant at 3519 Alhambra Cir., Coral Gables, FL 33134-6213 (Alhambra Cir. address).
- 3. On July 24, 2019, the Commission sent to the Appellant a notice of delinquency via certified mail to remind him of his obligation to file a 2018 CE Form 1. This notice was mailed to the Appellant at the Alhambra Cir. address. While the United States Postal Service (USPS) records indicate that the mailing was delivered, the identity of the recipient cannot be ascertained from the signature.
- 4. On August 20, 2019, the Commission also sent to the Appellant a postcard intended to remind him of his obligation to file a 2018 CE Form 1. This postcard was mailed to the Alhambra Cir. address.
- 5. On September 3, 2019, the Appellant requested from the Commission via email an extension for filing his 2018 CE Form 1. In his extension request, which was timely made, the Appellant stated that his 2018 federal tax returns could not be completed timely due to an ongoing dispute with his business partner and that he needed an extension to resolve the dispute and determine his financial assets.
- 6. The Commission's Chair granted the Appellant's extension request pursuant to Section 112.3151, Florida Statutes. The Appellant was required to file his 2018 CE Form 1 on or before October 15, 2019.
- 7. The Appellant did not file his 2018 CE Form 1 within the extension period and, following the expiration of the extension period, incurred the maximum fine amount of \$1,500.
- 8. On February 10, 2020, the Commission sent to the Appellant a Notice of Assessment of Automatic Fine via certified mail. The notice was sent to the Appellant's Alhambra

Cir. address. It indicated the total of the Appellant's accrued automatic fine, and included a notice of the right to appeal the fine, stating that the appeal had to be received by the Commission by March 11, 2020, to be considered timely. Records from USPS indicate that the mailing was returned to the Commission unclaimed.

- 9. On June 11, 2021, the Commission sent to the Appellant the second and final Notice of Assessment of Automatic Fine. This notice was sent to the Appellant's Alhambra Cir. address. This notice informed the Appellant that if he did not pay the assessed fine by July 12, 2021, the Commission will enter a Default Final Order against the Appellant for failure to file his 2018 CE Form 1. No payment was received by July 12, 2021.
- 10. On September 15, 2021, a Default Final Order was entered against the Appellant. Pursuant to the Default Final Order, the Appellant had until October 18, 2021, which was thirty (30) days from the date of the order to pay the \$1,500 fine to the Commission whereafter non-payment would result in collection proceedings. A notification of issuance of default final order including a copy of the default order, was mailed to the Appellant's Alhambra Cir. address.
- 11. On October 18, 2021, the Appellant spoke with Commission staff over the telephone and stated that he had been living and traveling between the United States and Spain and requested information on filing an appeal before the Commission.
- 12. On January 12, 2022, the Appellant submitted his 2018 CE Form 1 to the Commission.
- 13. On January 13, 2022, the Commission received the Appellant's Appeal of Automatic fine for Form Year 2018. In part B of the appeal form, the Appellant checked "Lack of Notification Failure to receive notice" as the reason for his appeal. In part C of the appeal form, where the Appellant is asked to provide a detailed explanation of his appeal including why

the options they selected in part B of their form are applicable to their situation, the Appellant states that he never received a timely notification of his form filings because he was living part time in Madrid, Spain from 2018 to 2020. The Appellant further explains that his employment required him to fly to Madrid to farm investors for specific projects within the United States. The Appellant also explains that he has been involved in settling a dispute with his former business partner due to which he has been unable to acquire accurate information about his financials. To support his claim, the Appellant has attached detailed immigration and emigration records from and to Madrid, Spain – totaling to about 14 documented entry and exit port visa stamps during the years 2019 and 2020. The Appellant did request a hearing.

Conclusions of Law

- 14. The Commission has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this proceeding pursuant to Section 112.3145, Florida Statutes.
- 15. Financial disclosure is required of public officials and employees because it enables the public to evaluate potential conflicts of interest, deters corruption, and increases public confidence in government.
 - 16. Section 112.3145(8)(g)3., Florida Statutes, states:

Any reporting person may appeal or dispute a fine, based upon unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date, and may request and is entitled to a hearing before the commission, which may waive the fine in whole or in part for good cause shown. Any such request must be in writing and received by the commission within 30 days after the notice of payment due is transmitted. In such a case, the reporting person must, within the 30-day period, notify the person designated to review the timeliness of reports in writing of his or her intention to bring the matter before the commission. For purposes of this subparagraph, the term "unusual circumstances" does not include the failure to monitor an e-mail account or failure to receive notice

- if the person has not notified the commission of a change in his or her e-mail address.
- 17. Appellant was notified of his appellate rights by notice on February 10, 2020, and informed that his appeal needed to be received by the Commission on or before March 11, 2020, in accordance with the 30-day appeal period allowed by Section 112.3145(8)(g)3., Florida Statutes. Appellant did not timely file an appeal. Appellant then filed his appeal on January 13, 2022, which was outside the 30-day window.
- 18. "An elementary and fundamental requirement of due process in any proceeding which is to be accorded finality is notice reasonably calculated, under all the circumstances, to apprise interested parties of the pendency of the action and to afford them an opportunity to present their objections." Mullane v. Cent. Hanover Bank, 339 U.S. 306, 314(1950).
- 19. Appellant was mailed notice of his appellate rights and of his opportunity to be heard, and did not timely file an appeal. However, his notice of appellate rights were likely mailed during the time that the Appellant was outside the United States. The notice itself was returned to the Commission as unclaimed mail. Considering the fact that the notice was returned unclaimed, and the evidence submitted to support the Appellant's claim of being abroad during February and March of 2020, his appeal is accepted as timely filed.
- 20. Turning to the merits of Appellant's appeal, his basis for appealing the fine is that he did not timely receive the mail containing the notification for filing the 2018 Form 1 and the Assessment Notice thereafter. There is no evidence to conclusively refute the Appellant's claim. On the contrary, the Appellant's detailed immigration and emigration records from and to Madrid, Spain totaling to about 14 documented entry and exit port visa stamps during the years 2019 and 2020 shows that the Appellant did not timely receive the mailings. The Appellant's absence from

the country during 2019 and 2020 does constitute "unusual circumstances" that justify waiving the \$1,500 fine.

Order

Based on the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission hereby rescinds the Default Final Order entered on September 15, 2021, and waives the assessed fine of \$1,500.

The Commission on Ethics has received a request for an extension of time to file a CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, on behalf of the above-referenced individual who, as the Member of the Board of Medicine for the Department of Health, as well as a Board Member for CareerSource South Florida, is required to file a 2018 CE Form 1 no later than the expiration of the filing grace period, which was September 3, 2019. In his request, which was timely submitted on September 3, 2019, Mr. Perez indicates that he requires additional time to file since his 2018 tax returns—which are presumably required in order to accurately complete the CE Form 1 filing—are not yet completed due to a dispute being worked out with his business partner. Mr. Perez is requesting an extension until October 15, 2019, which amounts to a forty-two (42) day extension.

The Commission has delegated to its chair the authority to grant an extension of up to the statutory maximum of 45 days. Therefore, without a vote of the entire Commission, extensions granted for good cause pursuant to Section 112.3151, Florida Statutes, may not exceed 45 days.



NOTICE OF ASSESSMENT OF AUTOMATIC FINE

The Commission on Ethics hereby gives notice of an assessment of a fine against you pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes, due to your failure to timely file your 2018 CE Form 1, Statement Of Financial Interests. Under the law, your 2018 CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, was due by July 1, 2019. The law provided for a penalty-free grace period extending the due date to September 3, 2019. After that date, you accrued fines of \$25.00 per day for each day your financial disclosure was late, up to the maximum fine of \$1,500.00 (60 days late), pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes.

Inasmuch as your 2018 CE Form 1 has not been filed with the Commission on Ethics within the 60 days of the grace period date (September 3, 2019), you have accrued the maximum fine amount of \$1,500.00. This fine must be paid to the Commission on Ethics within 30 days of the date of this notice unless you appeal the fine to the Commission. The Commission has the authority to consider the appeal and waive the fine in whole or in part if your failure to file on time was due to "unusual circumstances" surrounding the failure to file. Unless the fine is successfully appealed, the Commission is required to investigate public officers and employees who receive the maximum \$1,500 fine, to determine whether their failure to file was willful. The penalty for willfully failing to file disclosure is removal from public office or employment.

- 4. **DUE DATE:** Your appeal must be <u>received</u> by the Commission on Ethics on or before <u>March 11, 2020</u>. <u>NOTE</u>: Failure to timely file an appeal will constitute a waiver of your right to appeal and will result in the entry of a default order against you.
- 5. UNUSUAL CIRCUMSTANCES: An appeal must demonstrate that you submitted your CE Form 1 after the extended due date because of "unusual circumstances." "Unusual circumstances" is defined in Commission Rule 34-8.215(4), Florida Administrative Code, as "uncommon, rare, or sudden events over which the reporting individual had no control and which directly result in the failure to act in accordance with the filing requirements." Therefore, circumstances that allowed for time to take steps necessary to file on time do not constitute "unusual circumstances" that will allow the Commission to waive the fine. You have the burden to establish "unusual circumstances." Your appeal must specifically state the circumstances that led to your not filing by September 3, 2019, and must include any documentation or evidence supporting your appeal, such as:
 - a. **SICKNESS/INJURY:** a statement from attending physician, including dates and nature of the illness or injury;
 - b. LACK OF NOTICE (WRONG ADDRESS): documentation that you did not reside at the address to which notice was sent:

DEFAULT FINAL ORDER

This matter comes before the Commission on Ethics for the failure of Andre Maurice Perez to pay the assessed fine. Pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes, the Florida Commission on Ethics is charged with assessing automatic fines of \$25 per day up to a maximum of \$1500 for persons who are required to file financial disclosure but who either file late, or not at all.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Andre Maurice Perez, Health, Department of -Boards, Bd of Medicine, was on the list of persons required to file a Statement of Financial Interests for the year 2018.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 112.3145(8)(g), Florida Statutes, Andre Maurice Perez was mailed a copy of the 2018 CE Form 1 no later than June 1, 2019, and was mailed a delinquency notice by certified mail no later than July 31, 2019. Additional attempts to contact Andre Maurice Perez were also made by Commission staff.
- 3. However, Andre Maurice Perez did not file a 2018 CE Form 1 by the designated due date. Andre Maurice Perez was sent a notice of payment due advising of the statutory rights to appeal or dispute the automatic fine in a hearing before the Commission if such appeal was received within 30 days of the notice of payment due. No timely appeal was received from Andre Maurice Perez.

- 4. More than 60 days have elapsed since the notice of payment due was transmitted without Andre Maurice Perez paying the fine.
- 5. On its own motion, the Commission voted to affirm that a fine in the amount of \$1500 has accrued in this matter.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 6. The Commission has jurisdiction over the parties to and subject matter of this case, pursuant to Section 112.3145, Florida Statutes.
- 7. Andre Maurice Perez's failure to timely appeal the assessed fine constitutes a waiver of the entitlement to an appeal, pursuant to Rule 34-8.215(2), Florida Administrative Code.

ORDER

- 8. Pursuant to Section 112.3145(8) and 112.31455, Florida Statutes, the Commission on Ethics shall attempt to determine whether Andre Maurice Perez is currently a public officer or public employee receiving salary or wages from a governmental entity. If so, the matter will be referred to either the Chief Financial Officer for the State of Florida or the governing body for Health, Department of -Boards, as appropriate, for withholding of salary until the debt is satisfied.
- 9. If Andre Maurice Perez is no longer a public officer or employee, or if the Commission cannot determine filer's status, the matter will be referred to the Florida Department of Financial Services for collection or wage garnishment.

WHEREFORE, the automatic fine that Andre Maurice Perez accrued in the amount of \$1500 is affirmed. The fine shall be paid to the Florida Commission on Ethics within 30 days of

the date this Default Final Order is entered. After that date, nonpayment will result in collection as provided for in Section 112.3145(8) and 112.31455, Florida Statutes.


