ORDER ON REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

The Commission on Ethics has received a request for an extension of time to file a CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, on behalf of the above-referenced individual who, as a Member of the Board of Funeral, Cemetery & Consumer Services under the Department of Financial Services, is required to file a 2023 CE Form 1 no later than July 1, 2024. A timely request for an extension of time to file the 2023 CE Form 1 has been brought by Pam Mills on Joseph Brandenburg's behalf stating, as grounds, that he is currently in a medical facility without access to a computer and will be under their care for several months. The request asks for a four-month extension.

Section 112.3151, Florida Statutes, allows the Commission to grant, for good cause, an extension of time for filing disclosure. Good cause having been shown, the request is hereby GRANTED, and Mr. Brandenburg shall have an extension until and including November 1, 2024. *Should Mr. Brandenburg require another extension, he should notify the Commission prior to the end of the November 1, 2024, extension period.*
