Extension Request 25-24

SECOND ORDER ON REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

The Commission on Ethics has received a request for an extension of time to file a CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, on behalf of the above-referenced individual who, as a member of the Police Officers' Pension Board of Deerfield Beach, is required to file a 2024 CE Form 1 no later than the expiration of the grace period, which is September 2, 2025. The request, which was timely submitted, asks for additional time on behalf of Mr. Giuffreda, as he is currently hospitalized and has been in the hospital for the past two months due for a broken hip and other injuries. Based on the request, the Chair previously granted an initial 45-day extension through October 17, 2025. However, Mr. Giuffreda has requested a three-month extension to December 2, 2025, to give him time to accurately complete the 2024 CE Form 1 as he continues his recovery.

Section 112.3151, Florida Statutes, allows the Commission to grant, for good cause, an extension of time for filing disclosure. Good cause having been shown, the request is hereby GRANTED, and Mr. Giuffreda shall have until and including December 2, 2025, file his 2024 CE Form 1. *Should Mr. Giuffreda require another extension, he should notify the Commission prior to the end of the December 2, 2025, extension period.*

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ORDER ON REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

The Commission on Ethics has received a request for an extension of time to file a CE Form 1, Statement of Financial Interests, who, as a member of the Police Officers' Pension Board of Deerfield Beach, is required to file a 2024 CE Form 1 no later than the expiration of the grace period, which is September 2, 2025. Per the extension request by Kimberly Holmes on behalf of Mr. Giuffreda, Mr. Giuffreda has been in the hospital for the past two months due to a broken hip and other injuries. Given his condition, he requires additional time to fill out his form as he continues his recovery, and requests a three-month extension.

The Commission has delegated to its chair the authority to grant an extension of up to the statutory maximum of 45 days. Therefore, without a vote of the entire Commission, extensions granted for good cause pursuant to Section 112.3151, Florida Statutes, may not exceed 45 days. Good cause having been shown, the request is hereby GRANTED, and Mr. Giuffreda may have a 45-day extension until and including October 17, 2025. Mr. Giuffreda's request for a three-month extension until and including December 2, 2025, will be placed before the Commission for a determination during the September 12, 2025 Commission meeting.
