TALLAHASSEE—February 1, 2022— The State of Florida Commission on Ethics, in its public session meeting on January 21, unanimously elected JOHN GRANT, as Chair for the 2022-2023 term beginning February 1, 2022. Mr. Grant was appointed by Governor DeSantis in 2019 and subsequently reappointed in 2021. He currently practices law in the Tampa Bay area and teaches law and criminal justice at the college level. Mr. Grant previously served as a Legislator in both the Florida House of Representatives and the Florida Senate. This is his third time serving on the Commission. GLENTON "GLEN" GILZEAN, JR. was unanimously elected Vice Chair. Mr. Gilzean has a history as an advocate for disadvantaged youth and families.
