## FINAL ORDER AND PUBLIC REPORT

The State of Florida Commission on Ethics, meeting in public session on January 25, 2019, adopted the Joint Stipulation of Fact, Law, and Recommended Order entered into between the Advocate for the Commission and the Respondent in this matter.

In accordance with the Stipulation, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference, the Commission finds that the Respondent, who served as the Fire Chief, acting City Manager, and/or City Manager for the City of Madeira Beach, violated Section 112.313(6), Florida Statutes, by keeping or storing his jet ski on a City jet ski lift.

For the violation, in accordance with the Stipulation, the Commission hereby recommends a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,000, and restitution to the City of Madeira Beach in the amount of \$2,320, for a total of \$4,320, penalties which the Respondent has agreed to be subjected to and to pay.
